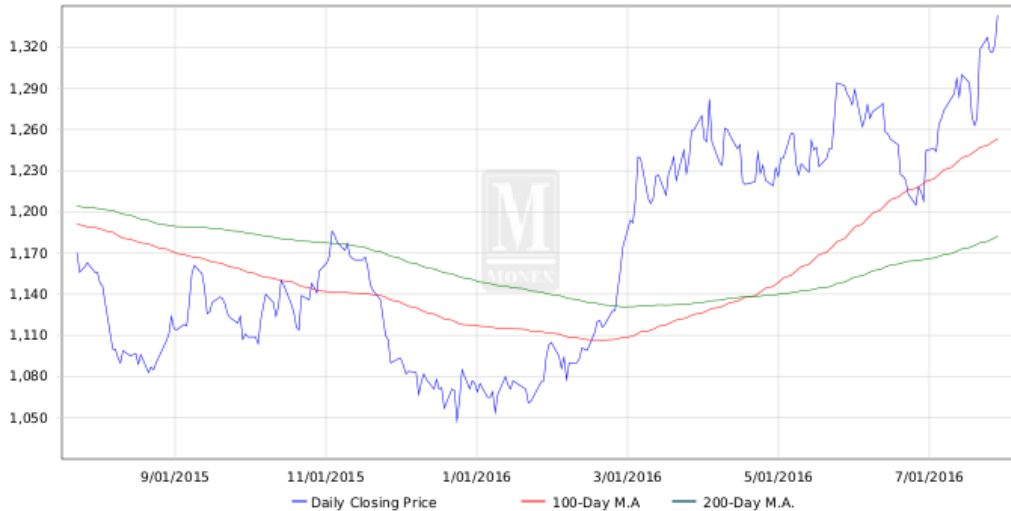

The US Mint has scheduled a number of coins and coin sets to be produced over this next year. Here is a list of a **portion** of those productions. For more information, please go to the US Mint website.

August 25, 2016 - Theodore Roosevelt National Park Quarter Launches

November 17, 2016 - Fort Moultrie / Fort Sumter National Monument Quarter Launches

SHOW & TELL – *Something Gold Night*

Gene B. presented a small vial of gold dust he had extracted from the north fork of the Yuba River through the gold panning technique he had talked about at the May meeting.

Lloyd C. presented two (2) ancient gold Roman Empire coins that were minted during the 5th century AD, and discussed the history of that era as represented by the coins.

Don B. presented two (2) large medals created by the US Mint to commemorate the Doolittle Raiders of WW2 and air races, along with pictures and written descriptions of each.

Michael T. presented a full color book on the history of US gold coins entitled “United States Gold Coins – An Illustrated History” and described how the author came to create the book, which is now a recognized definitive book on US gold coins.
