



CSNA AND NCNA TO HOLD JOINT FORUM

The California State Numismatic Association (CSNA) has partnered with the Northern California Numismatic Association (NCNA) to hold together the Northern California Numismatic Education Forum on **Saturday, November 18th, 2023 in Vallejo, California**, returning to prior venue for these annual Joint Forum's, the **Vallejo Naval and Historical Museum.**

Registration opens at 8:30 AM, and the first presentation starts at 9:30 AM. The Museum is at '734 Marin, at Capital, downtown Vallejo, California'.

The theme for the 2023 Joint Forum is 'Ancients Plus Much More'. Three fine and qualified presenters have been confirmed. They are Marina Fischer, the current Curator of Numismatics from the University of Calgary, Alberta, Canada and Ancient coinage scholar, with her 'Octavian: The Birth of the Roman Empire'. Also, for his first-time participation is Jose Raul Ramirez, retired university professor and note Hispanic scholar residing in Berkley, California, with his 'Reales to Pesos'. Adding would be 'Doctor' Lloyd G. Chan, retired educator and professional award-winning winemaker plus farmer living in the Suisun Valley, California, with his always enjoyed 'Alexander The Great: The Man, and His Coins'.

As of August 2023, these three have been scheduled. An additional fourth presenter, either a dual team emphasizing 'youth numismatics' and 'Scouting and Coins' or a local noted numismatic activist with 'Hawaiian Coinages and History.' The intention is for two presenters in the morning hours and for two in the afternoon.

Along with the presentations, there would be a special gift for each attendee plus 'free giveaways'. A simple on-site lunch service would be available as well eateries within walking distance, including a Saturday 'Farmer's Market' a block away. In addition, a special enticement drawing would be held for attendees to win Silver Eagles for local coin clubs. The Joint Forum is **FREE**, and the entire Museum is open to all attendees.

This year's Joint Forum continues the cooperative and coordinated effort of CSNA and NCNA to promote 'the world of money', numismatics among coin hobbyists and others. Primary funding is budgeted by NCNA, via generous Patrons.
